## HOW TO SPEND YOUR FEMA MONEY WISELY

FEMA WILL TELL YOU THE TYPES OF ASSISTANCE YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO RECEIVE.

- Home repairs (structure, water, septic, and sewage systems)
- Rental assistance for a different place to live temporarily
- Repair or replacement of a damaged primary vehicle
- Uninsured out-of-pocket medical expenses for an injury caused by the disaster
- Repair or replacement of occupational specialized tools
- Essential educational materials (computer, schoolbooks, supplies, etc.)
- Moving and storage expenses related to the disaster

NOTE: IF YOU DO NOT SPEND THE AWARD MONEY FOR ITS INTENDED PURPOSE, YOU MAY BE DENIED FUTURE ASSISTANCE OR BE ASKED TO PAY BACK THE MONEY RECEIVED.
